Please complete the exam with the newest version of the USA Shooting Rulebook revised February 1, 2007. USA Shooting rules override ISSF Rules for this test. **REMEMBER:** use specific rules, not generalities and there may be more than one rule that applies, show all applicable rules.

No.	Question	T / F	Rule
1	The use of any special devises, means or garments, which immobilize movement of the body, are not prohibited.		
2	In the interest of safety a shooter or official may stop shooting at any time.		
3	If a shooter arrives late for his match start time he is automatically eliminated from the competition.		
4	Shooters are to report 20 minutes before the scheduled starting time for finals.		
5	At least one clock is required for USA Shooting sanctioned competitions.

6	In USA Shooting sanctioned competitions, final entries must be completed prior to the start of the event.		
7	A jury member may be a competition official, shooter or team official in that competition		
8	Inner tens are only for the guidance of the shooters and are not used for any other reason.		
9	In rifle events, which last more than one day, all shooters must fire an equal number of shots each day.		
10	Equipment control is mandatory at all USA Shooting sanctioned competition.		
11	It is the duty of the range officer to check the shooter's position.		
12	In USA Shooting sanctioned competition, a third qualified scorer may resolve the question of shot value.		
13	The shooting program for 50-meter small bore rifle three position is 130 shots in three positions.

14	The size of the ten ring is the same for the 50-meter and the 50-yard target.		
15	In USA Shooting sanctioned competitions, shots that have been plugged must be marked with a plus or minus and initialed by the scorers.		
16	A jury of appeal decision is final.		
17	All shooters in the immediate vicinity of the firing line must wear earplugs.		
18	In 10m rifle, men and women, both shoot 60 shots.		
19	The rules are only a guideline, it is not the responsibility of the competitor to know or understand them.		
20	In the small bore rifle prone match the time to shoot 60 shots is 1 hour, 30 minutes plus time for sighters.		
21	A computer with a random selection program can do squadding.

22	Organizing committees or competition sponsors may apply for USA Shooting sanction of a competition.		
23	In the air rifle competition, after the first shot has been fired the competitor cannot release a propelling charge without it being counted as a miss.		
24	Wind flags are never used on 300-yard ranges.		
25	Jury decisions may not be based on applicable USA Shooting regulations and rules.		
26	In finals a sighting time of 5 minutes is permitted.		
27	The total thickness of the shooting glove must not exceed 12 mm.		
28	In all rifle finals, 75 seconds is allowed for each shot.		
29	Corrective lenses must not be attached to the rifle.

30	The organizing committee must supply printed forms for submitting written protests.		
31	A thumbhole stock is not allowed on an air rifle.		
32	No velcro or sticky substances may be applied to the outside of the jacket.		
33	If a substitute rifle is used it must be approved by equipment control.		
34	Sighting targets must be clearly marked.		
35	Adult participants, except collegiate, in USA Shooting sanctioned competition must be individual members of USA Shooting.		
36	If a shooter wears shoes, they must be a matched pair.		
37	If a shooter receives a confirmed crossfire and it is impossible to determine which shot is his, he must be credited with the value of the highest undetermined shot.

38	The maximum sling width is 40 mm.		
39	Any shooter or team official has the right to protest a condition of the competition.		
40	At the start of the competition shooters can take whatever point they want on the range.		
41	The use of a spotting scope is permitted for 50m events.		
42	In USA Shooting sanctioned competitions, fees and scores must be sent to USA Shooting within 30 days.		
43	If a shooter alters a rifle or equipment which has already been checked so that it no longer meets the rules, the shooter must be disqualified.		
44	A shooter cannot be disqualified because of clothing.		
45	Lots are drawn by the Classification Jury to determine finals start positions when an unbreakable tie occurs among two or more finalists.

46	An open team is defined as any team representing a USA Shooting affiliated club or organization in common.		
47	In USA Shooting sanctioned competitions, a fee of not more than \$5.00 may be charged for a scoring protest.		
48	All drugs on the current IOC and ISSF prohibited substances lists are banned.		
49	Manipulating clothing before or after testing is encouraged for testing.		
50	All shooters at all levels of competition must wear start numbers.
